

Tips for sustainable traveling.




In fact, I am looking forward for more attending more such sessions in future and encouraging my friends in participating in such sessions to learn more about biodiversity and its different aspects.





The members of the Biodiversity Cell and a team from Symbiosis Statistical Institute (SSI), organized a session on the 'Importance of Wildlife Outside Protected Areas.' Mr. Hrishikesh Wagh, who is a young Environmentalist, spoke specifically about leopards. He has done his research on wildlife and its conservation; and continues to work with passion in this field.

The session started on time at 4;00PM with the introduction from the Head of the Biodiversity Cell. This was followed by a welcome address by Ms. Ritu Bhasin, who is a student from SSI. There were about 35 participants throughout the session who listened with enthusiasm and interest.

From Symbiosis College of Nursing, I, Ms. Akshara Bansod was the only participant. Soon after the welcome address and the introduction of the speaker, Mr. Hrishikesh Wagh took over. He spoke about his interest in wildlife and how he acquired the curiosity about leopards while growing up. He decided to give his interest an educational background and hence, he is now an environmentalist at a very young age.

Mr. Hrishikesh has received a lot of appreciation and feedback from well-known personalities for his distinctive work and research. The speaker talked in detail about how to identify the tracks of a leopard and what it consumes. He also highlighted the importance of conserving these species and creating a friendly environment for them with the help of National Parks.

The entire session was very informative, thought provoking and provided the participants with new knowledge, which is rarely talked about.

Mr. Hrishikesh had a very interesting way of presentation, as he used pictures, which he himself had taken, that made the session even more absorbing.


There was a Q&A session at the end of the presentation. Many students had their doubts, which were explained in detail.



She started this in November 2016 and by April 2017 her form was able to stop 5000 gunny bags of dry leaves from being burnt the leaves were introduced for different purposes like mulching and composting.

- 1. Mulching


Mulching is a process of crushing of dry leaves with hands and place those leaves in plant bed/ pot covering the soil completely.




2. Composting

It's a second process of adding dry leaves to a compost bin, or pile them up in corner of yard. Then the leaves with a nitrogen rich item, like cottonseed meal, grass clipping. Build the pile up until its three feet tall and wide. And then turn the compost once a month.


#### 3. Receive Donate

This is the 3<sup>rd</sup> step brown leaf three fold strategy of managing dry leaves in eco-friendly manner.

Receive or donate brown leaves to the people who want for mulching and composting.





The #Epledge will motivate each citizen to take a conscious and collaborative effort to prevent using tobacco for at least 24 hours.


